Securely Dispose of Unwanted Paper and Electronics

Shred Event Saturday, June 1, 2024

Join the community and participate in a one-day paper shredding and electronics recycling event on June 1, 2024. Hosted by several area credit unions, this event offers WinCU members the chance to dispose of paper documents and a variety of electronics securely and responsibly.

Bring up to five bags of paper to the parking lot of Oshkosh Corporation located at 1917 FOUR WHEEL DRIVE.

You can also dispose of electronic items such as DVD players and VCRs, audio equipment, cabling and wires, coffee makers, computer mouse and towers, keyboards, controllers, gaming systems, iPods, and more. Please note that fees will apply for certain items including copy machines, dishwashers, mini/dorm size refrigerators, freon-containing items, microwaves, stoves, TVs, washers, and dryers. Stay tuned for upcoming WinCU emails that will provide more details about this event.



Fighting Hackers

Use these valuable tips to fight off cyber thieves.

- Use two-factor authentication or multi-factor authentication for logins whenever possible. If required, you enter a uniquely generated code that is sent to your phone before you can gain access to an account.
- Turn on updates to your devices, computers, and phones, so you have the most up-to-date fraud-blocking systems and apps.
- Use unique, elaborate passwords, but also use a password management system such as 1Password, Bitwarden, LastPass, or Dashland to keep them protected and to sync the information on all devices.
- If you have an iPhone, you can turn on "Find My iPhone," which enables Activation Lock and helps secure your Apple identity.
- Freeze your credit at Equifax, Experian, and TransUnion to prevent someone from opening a credit card in your name.
- Create a dedicated email account you only use for financial services and not for personal or work email.
- Never click on links in texts or emails asking you to update your P2P information. Many of these are scams.
- If you think you've been scammed, contact the credit union immediately!

Remember, do NOT respond to random texts, emails, or calls. We will never ask for personal or sensitive information through text, email, or calls. Instead, contact us directly at **920.233.9096** or visit us at an Oshkosh or Neenah branch. When in doubt, DELETE!


