As the holiday season approaches, it's important to be aware of potential scams that could threaten your financial security. Fraudsters often take advantage of the increased shopping and financial transactions during this time of year. By staying informed and vigilant, you can protect yourself and your loved ones from falling victim to these scams.

- Phishing Emails and Texts: Be cautious of unsolicited emails or texts that ask for personal or financial information.
 Scammers often impersonate legitimate businesses or financial institutions to trick recipients into revealing sensitive information. Avoid clicking on links or downloading attachments from unknown sources, and verify the legitimacy of any requests for personal information.

Keep track of your shipments, consider requiring a signature for delivery, and utilize secure delivery options if available. 
