

Since 2002, credit unions across the nation celebrate Youth Month every April by promoting financial literacy and encouraging young people to develop healthy saving habits. In fact, years prior, Wisconsin's credit unions provided over 55,000 hours of free, certified financial counseling across the state, and Governor Tony Evers even proclaimed April as Financial Literacy and Capability Month in Wisconsin.

WinCU takes financial education seriously throughout the year, and finds opportunities to collaborate with our members and community partners to promote financial wellness. We aim to engage young members and their families to join a credit union by offering free kids accounts, and they get a backpack filled with additional fun items like an "It's Money Time" activity book. This not only fosters a long-term relationship and makes the CU a fun place to visit, but it also builds a foundation for financial well-being with us. We also focus on encouraging kids and teens to keep learning the value of saving early, with the support of our credit union community. Throughout the month, we incentivize saving by offering to match the first \$10 kids deposit into their accounts.

This year, the month aligned with Money Smart Wisconsin week, which promotes financial literacy and awareness through financial education classes, activities, and opportunities for Wisconsinites by bringing together different organizations and facilitating the sharing of expertise, leveraging limited resources, and expanding community participation in financial education efforts. The Money Smart Wisconsin campaign for 2025 included

"The Big Read," a statewide effort where adults at dozens of locations will read books with personal finance lessons to children in pre-kindergarten through fourth grade. Winnebago participated in several of the events including "The Big Read with Fang" at the Timber Rattler stadium, "Bite of Reality" career simulation at Valley New School, "The Big Read" at Oshkosh Public Library with a piggy bank painting activity and the "Make Money Count" free admission day at the Building for Kids Children's Museum in Appleton.

One thing at Winnebago that sets us apart from other financial institutions is our focus on providing kids and their families the opportunity to begin the savings journey. In fact, throughout the year, we offer free Youth Accounts with the WinCU Kids Club. Kids can earn up to \$30 with the following:

- We'll make the opening \$5 deposit and kids receive a free WinCU piggy bank
- Earn \$5 to for each "top" grade report (1 per semester, 2x a yr)
- Fill a deposit book with stamps for another \$5 (2 books per yr)
- Go fishing for coin every birthday (earn up to \$5)

These programs highlight the importance of teaching children and teens about saving, budgeting, and other essential financial skills. It's never too early to start learning the lessons of financial education at any age, but the most important step is the first one!

Dive into Fun at the Pool



Romance Scams: Scammers exploit online dating, gaining trust before asking for money for emergencies or travel.

Tech Support Scams: Fraudsters pose as tech support, claiming a virus on the computer and requesting remote access or payment for fake services.

Prize Scams: Seniors receive notices claiming they've won a prize but must pay a fee or provide personal info to claim it.

Home Repair Scams: Unscrupulous contractors offer unsolicited services, then demand more money for subpar work.

Verify Identity: Always confirm the identity of anyone requesting personal information.

Trust Your Instincts: Consult family or friends if something seems suspicious.

Annual Winnebago Meeting

Our 71st Annual Meeting was held on March 6th at the LaSure's Banquet Hall. Chairperson Tom Geske reported loans grew by \$867 thousand to \$129.5 million, and assets increased to \$158.4 million. Credit union membership is now over 8,500. Members elected incumbent board member Karen Koelbl to a three-year volunteer term.
